Guidance for use of Standard Form-182 for Procurement

For Federal Government clients using the SF-182 (Authorization, Agreement and Certification of Training - Dec 2006)

The workshops are designed to meet the following criteria:

Training Purpose Type: 03 - Improve/Maintain Present Performance

Training to provide the knowledge, skills and abilities needed to improve or maintain proficiency in present job.

Training Type Code: 01 - Training Program Area

Training Type Sub Code: 07 - Planning and Analysis

Education or training in the concepts, principles, and theories of systems analysis; policy, program or management analysis; or planning, including strategic planning.

Training Delivery Type Code: 01 – Traditional Classroom (no technology)

Individual or multiple person led, face-to-face training.

Training Designation Type Code: 05 - N/A and N/A

Training Source Type Code: 03 – Non-government

Sources include commercial or industrial concern, educational institutions, professional societies or associations, or consultants or individuals who are not Government employees, (but are contracted to develop and/or provide training course or program.)

Training Objectives:

IBP-1A

- Apply critical thinking to analyze the incident environment
- Build an accurate common operating picture within a staff
- Identify and develop incident priorities and prioritized values at risk
- Formulate clear and concise leader's intent for the incident
- Develop incident objectives that meet the SMART criteria
- Effectively communicate leader's intent in both verbal and written form to incident resources and stakeholders

IBP-1B

- Create viable incident strategies for each objective
- Develop contingencies and trigger points
- Design an appropriate incident organization
- Develop task, purpose and end state for each tactical work assignment
- Conduct a risk assessment and determine acceptable risk for each assignment
- Effectively communicate leader's intent and associated risk in both verbal and written form to incident resources and stakeholders

IBP-2AB – Combination of IBP-1A and IBP-1B above.
